WHEREAS,

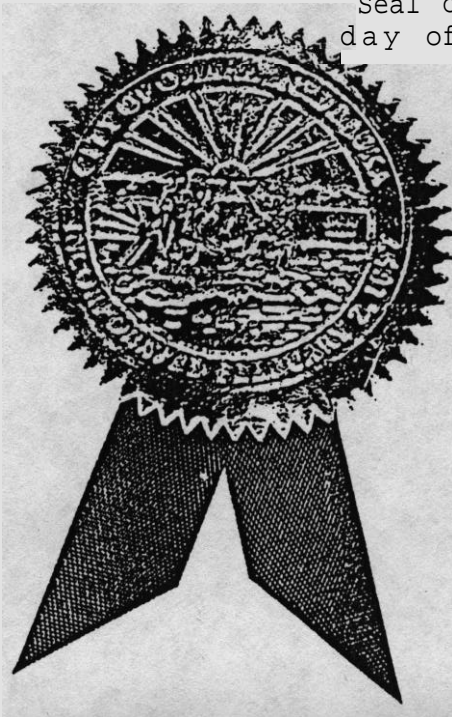
no American more exemplified this essential link in our national creed than the late Malcolm X, now known as Malcolm X Shabazz.
